## Dear Parents/Carers,

We are looking forward to welcoming all children back to school full time from Wednesday September $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$. We appreciate that some parents may be nervous about their child returning to school, however there is an expectation from the Government that all children will attend from this date. We will do everything we can to support all children as they return.

We recently received detailed government guidance which we will follow carefully ensuring that the health and safety of all children and staff is our priority. We will send out more information about our wider reopening plans next week but wanted to give you the following information in advance:

- School will be closed to all pupils (including keyworker/vulnerable children) from Monday 20th July to Tuesday lst September for the summer break. We would like to thank all of the staff who have worked continuously since the start of the pandemic, including during the Easter and Half Term holidays. We would also like to thank parents for their support during this challenging time.
- Breakfast Club will start again from Monday $14^{\text {th }}$ September, it will run from 7.45 am to 8.45 am . As part of our Risk Assessment, we are delaying the start date to ensure that our reopening plans are running effectively before we increase our provision. Please could you let the school office know as soon as possible if you would like to book your child a place.
- We will not be offering any after school clubs during September. We will review the situation early next term and hope to be able to start clubs again in October.
