We will have some limits on numbers so places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please complete and return the booking form previously sent out.

Uniform:

Uniform will remain as it did before Christmas. Children will wear a school t-shirt and jumper. They will wear a practical pair of plain jogging bottoms, leggings or shorts and trainers. This means there will be no need for them to change for outdoor sports and activities.

Year 5 and 6 <u>must</u> have a separate pair of indoor trainers/ shoes and outdoor trainers. They will be using the field/new Astro turf at lunchtimes. This will mean their outdoor shoes could get muddy. We would like to keep the classrooms as clean as possible so require Year 5 & 6 children to change into clean indoor shoes when they come inside.

Bags and Equipment:

Pupils will be able to bring a school bag in from 8th March but it needs to be one that is thoroughly cleanable/washable and only contains essential items such as packed lunch, a water bottle, homework











book, diary/reading record and reading book. Pencil cases will not be permitted into school. Other bags that have fur, fluff, sequins, lots of zips etc. will not be suitable for school as they cannot be easily cleaned. Please do not bring in bags that do not hang easily on the coat pegs/hangers.

Reading Books:

Children can now transfer reading books and record books between home and school as needed.

Homework:

Homework tasks and spellings will continue to be set via Class Dojo on Wednesdays and children will be asked to upload their work to their portfolios on a weekly basis.
