## What do we need to know about you?

Our school needs to know and keep some important stuff about you. Here's some of the things we must know and keep.

...but here's the funny thing - you and your parents or carers are in charge! The things we know, and keep, about you are called 'personal data'. Let's say 'data' for short.

As you grow older, we'll keep more and more data about you and the school MUST tell you what that is. If we want to use your data in a certain way, you can sometimes say:

# 'No, you can't do that, I won't allow it'

But if your data helps you to learn or to stay safe you can't say 'No, you can't use my data'

We want to help you learn and understand how to become a better person.


# OK that's good, but who will see and use my data?

Only people who need to see and use it to help you.

Your teachers and helpers.

The people who make school meals.







The people in the office and other important people who help you.









## But how long do you keep my data?



Only for as long as it is needed. Some will be thrown away quickly, but other stuff we'll need to keep longer.

...and whatever happens to it, we'll make sure it's kept safe and thrown away very safely.

## So, who else sees and uses my data?

There are lots of other people who help us to teach you, keep you safe, feed you, and who gather stuff to help everyone. We'll need to share your data with them. You'll know some but not all.

#### **Class Computer Tasks**

Computer support people look after the things you and your teachers do online.

#### **Important Officials**

The government and the council need to know where you are, how you are doing at school and where you may go next.

Doctors or a nurse may need to know and use your data.
