

Privacy Notice for Pupils

What do we need to know about you?

Our school needs to know and keep some important stuff about you. Here's some of the things we must know and keep.





...but here's the funny thing - you and your parents or carers are in charge!
The things we know, and keep, about you are called '**personal data**'. Let's say '**data**' for short.

As you grow older, we'll keep more and more **data** about you and the school **MUST** tell you what that is. If we want to use your **data** in a certain way, you can sometimes say:

'No, you can't do that, I won't allow it'

But if your **data** helps you to learn or to stay safe you can't say 'No, you can't use my **data**'

So why does the school need to know about me?



We want to make sure you grow, are healthy and understand more about the world around you.



We want to help you learn and understand how to become a better person.



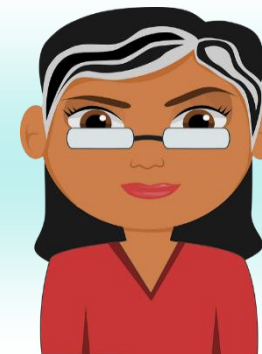
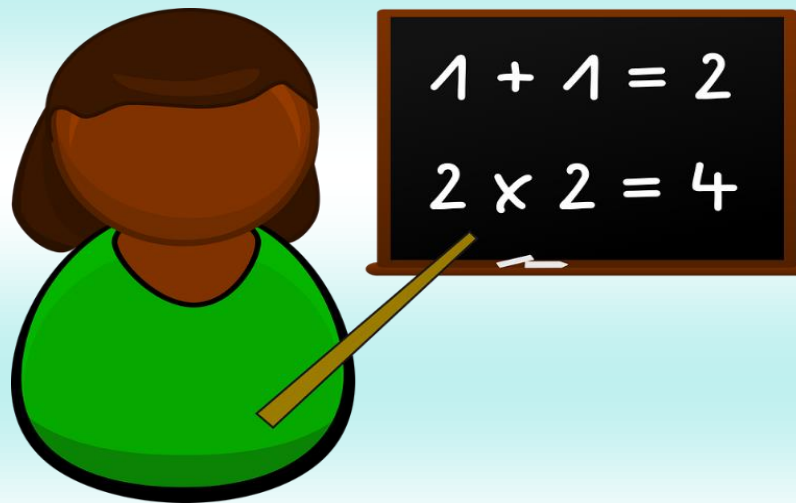
We want to keep you safe.

Your parents and carers

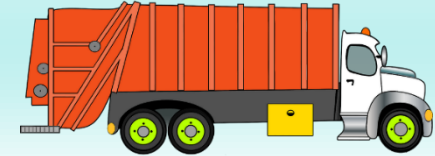


But how long do you keep my data?



Only for as long as it is needed. Some will be thrown away quickly, but other stuff we'll need to keep longer.

...and whatever happens to it, we'll make sure it's kept safe and thrown away very safely.



So, who else sees and uses my data?

There are lots of other people who help us to teach you, keep you safe, feed you, and who gather stuff to help everyone. We'll need to share your data with them. You'll know some but not all.

Teachers and the office store stuff about you.

Important Officials

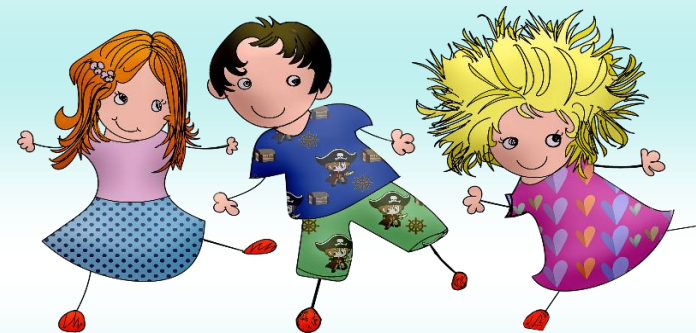
The government and the council need to know where you are, how you are doing at school and where you may go next. Doctors or a nurse may need to know and use your data.
